CLUB DISPLAY PITCH FEE: No charge.

CLUB DISPLAY PITCH AREA: 40ft x 40ft (12m x 12m) is standard. If more area required simply inform the organisers in advance.

CLUB DISPLAY COMPLIMENTARY PASSES: In order to keep admission and camping costs to the bare minimum, unlike the 'expensive shows' Jap 'n' Jeep Jam **will not** be supplying any Club Display complimentary passes. All members therefore have to pay for low cost day admission and/or camping fees in the usual manner.

CLUB DISPLAY COMPETITION: Whether entering the CLUB DISPLAY COMPETITION or not, please remember that all Club Displays will be viewed by the general public. Naturally we want to promote our hobby/sport/pastime in a good light, therefore clubs are encouraged to form a display that is both interesting and informative. Photo and information and boards are good, as are individual signs explaining what a particular vehicle is – the make/model/engine

size/modifications/history/etc. What nobody wants to see is just a boring line of vehicles! This is very important for your club and the show.

Suggested themes include an off-road woodland scene utilising rocks and logs OR a rally 'pit area' complete with dummies working on vehicles (this refers to mannequins - not live club members!) OR advertising/promoting a forthcoming event, competition or activity your club is organising OR a sand-strewn desert expedition or motorsport scene complete with plastic palm trees OR highlighting links with your local emergency rescue services (for instance many 4x4 clubs are on standby in times of flood or disaster) OR a scene depicting your locality (this is especially good if your home town is famous or a tourist attraction) OR if a one-marque club, vehicles showing changes through the years OR the club's links with a favourite charity OR anything else for that matter! Providing it is safe and of a non-commercial nature, anything is fair game. Please remember, it takes very little effort to create an interesting display, it brings the whole club together and the rewards are felt by everyone. All Club Displays will automatically be entered in the CLUB DISPLAY COMPETITION. Prizes are up for grabs!

NOTE: To meet our insurance requirements, all moving vehicles on site must be 'road legal'. Supervision when unloading/loading unregistered or non-road legal display vehicles is the responsibility of the club. No food/beverages to be sold/given from Club Display Stands. Unless by prior permission, the use of amplified public address systems and /or music is strictly prohibited. Generators must be either silent-running, or if an older model, baffled with boards to prevent nuisance to other traders/campers. Unless by prior written permission, generator shut down time is 11pm without exception.

Club committee members may camp overnight on their pitches or in the adjacent camp site. 'Trading' other than club merchandise within the showground is not permitted i.e. new goods/autojumble. Dogs under control are welcome - clean up essential! No open fires. There are no electrical hook-up's on site, however, the organisers can charge batteries for wheelchairs/mobility scooters, batteries for cameras/phones/etc. Mains drinking water is available. Although small in number, on site there are a couple of ceramic toilets (male & female) plus one shower. Health & Safety requirements including Risk Assessments, and Public Liability Insurance are the responsibility of the club. Should the event be postponed, abandoned, cancelled or re-located for whatever reason, the organiser shall not be liable in any way in respect of expenditure, liability or loss incurred by the club. The organiser reserves the right to refuse admission.

Arrival from noon Friday 11th June 2010, departure by 4pm Monday 14th June 2010

NOTE: To keep our costs down, take your rubbish home. Clubs flouting rule WILL be charged plus refused entry to future events.
